Good Afternoon Jack,

I have been meeting with Stef regarding some of the issues raised and we have some updates regarding them.

I have designed a new virtual footpath for Englishcombe Rd between Innox Grove and the old school, this will need to be approved before implementation. The signage on Englishcombe Rd (heading East out of Englishcombe) I agree also needs to be changed as it is cluttered and not ideal. A separate post with the terminal and pedestrian signage would be beneficial.

As shown below, the land up to the wall on the right hand side of this road is part of the adopted highways land, I believe it was unclear who the land belonged to upon site walkaround. Next to this location is a sign warning of pedestrians (specifically disabled) on the road, this could also be moved to a better position for visibility and changed to a standard pedestrian sign.

As pointed out on site visit, some areas of damaged surfaces will be sent over to the maintenance team to add to their list of works for refreshment.

In conclusion, I am hoping to have at least one of these works (preferably the virtual footway) done this financial year, but

ue to budget constraints may not be able to. If this is the case then it will be on the list of minor works to be completed use beginning of the next financial year and as the designs will be in place it should be fairly speedy.
