LGA Announces 2026 Local Government Pay Settlement

24 August 2026

The Local Government Association (LGA), acting on behalf of the National Joint Council (NJC) for Local Government Services, has announced that agreement has been reached on the 2026 pay award for local government employees. The settlement provides for a **3.3% increase in pay rates and allowances with effect from 1 April 2026**.

The agreed pay award covers the period from 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2027, and employers are being encouraged to implement the increase as quickly as possible.

For parish and town councils, the settlement will inform the annual update to the National Association of Local Councils (NALC) salary scales. While the annual SCP values are now available through the NJC agreement, councils should note that the hourly rates customarily published by NALC are calculated separately using NALC's methodology and working-time assumptions, and also cover salaries in the range above SCP43. Consequently, any hourly rates attached to the national announcement should be treated as indicative until NALC publishes its updated salary scales.

2026 SCP Annual Salary Values

The annual salary values for the core SCP range are as follows. To keep pace with the National Minimum Wage, the former SCP2 has been abolished from 1 April 2026:
